

Cookies Policy

Rotometal Sp. z o.o. is committed to protecting your privacy. We use cookies on this website to enable visitors to have the best possible experience. We collect analytics information to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the website and how our website is performing for our customers. This cookies policy tells you more about our use of cookies and the choices you have. The table below provides further details about the cookies which are currently in use on our websites and a description of the purpose of each of these cookies.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small files that websites place on your computer, mobile phone, tablet or other device. They remember that you have visited the website before. They make it easier for you to maintain your preferences and they enable certain features of the website to work, such as the shopping basket. They may also tailor the information or adverts you see on the site. This is important to us because we want to make sure our website is as user friendly as possible, ensuring you have a good experience when browsing or purchasing on our website.

In addition to the cookies managed by us and our service providers, some cookies are set by other companies which are part of wider advertising networks. Rotometal Sp. z o.o. website may use cookies from a list of known partners such as Google, Microsoft Bing to provide you with advertising tailored to your preferences both on this and other websites. We are providing this information to you as part of our policy and comply with the law relating to the use of cookies and other information storage technology operating on websites.

Types of Cookies

Session cookies: these are stored while you're browsing. They are deleted from your device automatically when you close your browser. Persistent cookies: these are saved on your computer so they don't get deleted when you close your browser. We use persistent cookies when we need to remember who you are from one visit to the next, for example to remember your preferences.

Below are more details of the cookies used on our website.

Strictly Necessary Cookies: These perform a variety of functions, such as keeping a visitor logged in to their account, retaining items in the shopping basket or if a quote is requested, ensuring information is displayed correctly on the website and recording whether visitors have accepted the use of cookies. Part of this includes security cookies which help prevent attacks on the website including attempts to steal the information a visitor enters on website forms. They also help identify fraudulent activity.

Performance Cookies: These cookies record a visitor's progress through a browsing session for problem solving and to identify errors in the use of the site that the visitor may experience. They also link a visitor's actions with website usage and performance. Some cookies identify the visitor's IP address, browser and device type. We use Analytics to assess how visitors use the website, to understand how visitors arrived at the site (e.g. using keyword searches), to monitor how long visitors remain on the website and when they return, and to control website traffic at busy times.

Social Media Cookies: Cookies track the products viewed by a visitor to the website and may serve similar adverts on when the user visits their Facebook and Twitter page. Other cookies enable visitors to share or like items on our website using social media buttons.

How can I manage or remove Cookies?

By default only strictly necessary cookies are active, as this is necessary for the operations of the websites. You can opt-in to other cookie categories (except strictly necessary cookies) by clicking on the "Cookie Settings" button, which will present you with multiple Cookie categories where you can click on the different category headings to find out more and change your default settings with the toggle button.

Within this, if you extend the Cookie category then you can see a list of cookies (first party and third party) which are active within that respective category. By choosing to "Allow All" you allow Rotometal Sp. z o.o. to use all the functionality of its Cookies and track as explained above. By choosing "Reject All" you disallow Rotometal Sp. z o.o. to use all the functionality of cookies categories, except those categorised as Strictly Necessary Cookies. Once you have selected your choices, you can click "Confirm My Choices" to complete this process.

If you want to, you can manage or disable cookies from your browser and delete all cookies that are stored on your device. You can do this as often you want to.
